Fees include plan review, hydrostratic test or visual inspection when required, and final inspection. Any special inspections or re-inspections required are billed at a rate of \$126.00/hour including drive time.

- 105.7.1** A construction permit is required for installation of or modification to an automatic fire-extinguishing system. Maintenance performed in accordance with this code is not considered to be a modification and does not require a permit.
- 105.7.2** A construction permit is required to install stationary storage battery systems regulated by Section 1206.2.
- 105.7.3** A construction permit is required to install capacitor energy storage systems regulated by Section 1206.3.
- 105.7.4** Where the compressed gases in use or storage exceed the amounts listed in Table 105.6.8, a construction permit is required to install, repair damage to, abandon, remove, place temporarily out of service, or close or substantially modify a compressed gas system.
- 105.7.5** A construction permit is required for installation of or alteration to outdoor stationary cryogenic fluid storage systems where the system capacity exceeds the amounts listed in Table 105.6.10. Maintenance performed in accordance with this code is not considered to be an alteration and does not require a construction permit.
- 105.7.6** A construction permit is required for installation of or modification to emergency responder radio coverage systems and related equipment. Maintenance performed in accordance with this code is not considered to be a modification and does not require a construction permit.
- 105.7.8** A construction permit is required for installation of or modification to fire pumps and related fuel tanks, jockey pumps, controllers and generators. Maintenance performed in accordance with this code is not considered to be a modification and does not require a construction permit.
- 105.7.9** A construction permit is required:
- 1** To install, repair or modify a pipeline for the transportation of flammable or combustible liquids.
 - 2** To install, construct or alter tank vehicles, equipment, tanks, plants, terminals, wells, fuel-dispensing stations, refineries, distilleries and similar facilities where flammable and combustible liquids are produced, processed, transported, stored, dispensed or used.
 - 3** To install, alter, remove, abandon or otherwise dispose of a flammable or combustible liquid tank.
- 105.7.10** A construction permit is required to install stationary fuel cell power systems
- 105.7.11** A construction permit is required for the installation of or modification to gas detection systems. Maintenance performed in accordance with this code is not considered a modification and shall not require a permit.
- 105.7.12** A construction permit is required for the installation of or modification to a gate or barricade across a fire apparatus access road.
- 105.7.13** A construction permit is required to install, repair damage to, abandon, remove, place temporarily out of service, or close or substantially modify a storage facility or other area regulated by Chapter 50 where the hazardous materials in use or storage exceed the amounts in Table 105.6.20.
- Exceptions:**
- 1** Routine Maintenance
 - 2** For repair work performed on an emergency basis, application for permit shall be made within two working days of commencement of work.
- 105.7.14** A construction permit is required for the installation of or modification to a structure exceeding 500 square feet (46 m²), including aisles, for high-piled combustible storage. Maintenance performed in accordance with this code is not considered to be a modification and does not require a construction permit.
- 105.7.15** A construction permit is required for installation of industrial ovens covered by Chapter 30.
- Exceptions:**
- 1** Routine Maintenance
 - 2** For repair work performed on an emergency basis, application for permit shall be made within two working days of commencement of work.
- 105.7.16** A construction permit is required for installation of or modification to an LP-gas system. Maintenance performed in accordance with this code is not considered to be a modification and does not require a permit.
- 105.7.17** A construction permit is required to install or modify a motor vehicle repair room or booth. Maintenance performed in accordance with this code is not considered to be a modification and does not require a permit.
- 105.7.18** A construction permit is required for installation of or modification to plant extraction systems. Maintenance performed in accordance with this code is not considered to be a modification and does not require a permit.
- 105.7.19** A construction permit is required for the installation or modification of private fire hydrants. Maintenance performed in accordance with this code is not considered to be a modification and does not require a permit.
- 105.7.20** Construction permits are required for installation of or alteration to smoke control or smoke exhaust systems. Maintenance performed in accordance with this code is not considered to be an alteration and does not require a permit.
- 105.7.21** A construction permit is required to install or modify solar photovoltaic power systems. Maintenance performed in accordance with this code is not considered to be a modification and does not require a permit.
- 105.7.22** A single construction permit is required to erect and take down a temporary special event structure.
- 105.7.23** A construction permit is required to install or modify a spray room, dip tank, or booth. Maintenance performed in accordance with this code is not considered to be a modification and does not require a permit.
- 105.7.24** A construction permit is required for the installation, modification or removal from service of a standpipe system. Maintenance performed in accordance with this code is not considered to be a modification and does not require a permit.
- 105.7.25** A construction permit is required to erect an air-supported temporary membrane structure, a temporary state canopy or a tent having an area in excess of 400 square feet.
