DIXON FIRE DEPARTMENT WELCOMES NEW FIRE ENGINE

The Dixon Fire Department recently put a new fire engine, Engine 81, into service. The 2023 Pierce Velocity fire engine was a joint purchase of the City of Dixon Fire Department and Dixon Fire Protection District.

"Engine 81 is equipped with the latest technology and advanced safety features, it will enhance our ability to respond to emergencies quickly and efficiently," said Battalion Chief Randy Shafer, "We look forward to serving our community with this new addition to our fleet."

Engine 81 is equipped with a Heedful Audio Alert System (HAAS) Alert Safety Cloud system which uses digital alerts to notify nearby drivers and other first responders of the engine's presence as soon as lights and sirens are activated.

Beginning with Engine 81, the Department is transitioning to a new engine color scheme. The Dixon Fire Department staff voted to select the color for future apparatus and Engine 81 introduces a new two-tone grey over red design.

"We are confident that this investment will enable us to better serve our community and would like to thank the community, City Council and city management for bringing this new engine to Dixon," said Shafer.

DIXON POLICE DEPARTMENT COMMENDS SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER JASON MALONE FOR EXEMPLARY SERVICE

After four transformative years, Officer Jason Malone, the first dedicated School Resource Officer (SRO) in the Dixon Police Department's history, will pass on his hall monitor duties and return to patrol. The Dixon Police Department is proud to acknowledge his commitment, dedication, and the profound impact he's made on our local schools.

Serving as the maiden dedicated, full-time SRO, Officer Malone set the bar incredibly high. Over the course of his assignment, he redefined what it meant to be a police officer in our schools, focusing not only on safety but on fostering positive relationships with students, staff, and the wider community.

Police Chief Robert Thompson noted, "Officer Malone has truly exemplified our department's values. His work at the school went beyond security - he became a mentor, a guide, and a friend to many. He showed our youth the role of the police is about protecting, serving, and investing in our community."

Malone's innovative programs, including outreach and campus safety, have significantly enhanced the trust and connection between the police department and the school community. He seamlessly blended in the school setting, sometimes mistaken for a teacher and coach – a testament to his dedication and rapport with the students.

"We couldn't be prouder of Jason," Thompson added. "He embraced the challenge of being our first SRO with enthusiasm and grace, navigating this new territory with a determination that set a remarkable precedent. He's leaving some big shoes to fill."

And who will be filling those sneakers? After an internal recruitment, with input from the administration of the Dixon Unified School District, a fresh "freshman" will be assigned next school year. Officer Christopher Kerner was selected, and is committed to carrying on the legacy Officer Malone has created.

Malone will return to a patrol assignment, where he will no doubt continue to uphold the high standards of the department. As for Dixon students, they can rest assured knowing Officer Malone is still in the city, keeping our community safe.

"To Officer Malone," Thompson said, "our gratitude is immeasurable. You may no longer walk the school halls, but your influence remains."

VACANCIES ON CITY COMMISSIONS

The City of Dixon is currently accepting applications for the following vacancies on City Commissions:

Three (3) vacancies on the Transportation Advisory Commission (TAC). The Transportation Advisory Commission is an advisory body to the City Council on matters pertaining to traffic, transportation, and parking issues. Commissioners serve four-year terms, with a maximum of two consecutive terms. All vacancies are four-year terms expiring on June 30, 2027. The TAC meets at 7:00 p.m. the third Wednesday of even- numbered months. City residency is required. A stipend of \$75.00 per meeting attended is paid to each Commissioner. The deadline to apply is June 2, 2023 at 5pm.

One (1) Student Representative, and one (1) Alternate Student Representative on the Parks and Recreation Commission. The Student Representative must be in his or her senior year of high school, and the Alternate Student Representative must be in his or her junior year of high school. The Commission is an advisory body to the City Council on matters pertaining to recreation programs and parks facilities. The Student Representative is expected to attend all Parks & Recreation Commission meetings. The Alternate Student Representative will fill in for the Student Representative, when the Student Representative is unable to attend Commission meetings. It is expected that the Alternate Student Representative will apply to become the Student Representative the following school year. The term to be served is July 1, 2023 - June 30, 2024.
