

HALLOWEEN SAFETY TIPS

Trick-or-Treating Safety



Plan Your Route: Stick to well-lit areas and familiar neighborhoods. Make sure someone knows where you'll be and when you'll return.



🔼 Adult Supervision: Young children should always go trick-or-treating with an adult. Older kids should go in groups and keep in touch with their parents.

Costume Safety:



Make sure costumes are flame-resistant and not too long to prevent tripping. Use reflective tape for visibility.



Check Candy: Before eating any treats, make sure to inspect them for tampering. When in doubt, throw it out.

Road Safety



Slow Down: If you're driving, be extra cautious. Children are excited and may move unpredictably.



🕟 Stay Alert: Avoid using your cell phone or any other distractions that could take vour focus off the road.

THE DIXON POLICE DEPARTMENT IS LOOKING FOR VOLUNTEERS FOR THE 2024 POINT IN TIME COUNT

The Dixon Police Department is looking for volunteers to help us address housing needs in our community and help track progress toward the goal of ending homelessness.

About the Point in Time Count

The purpose of the HUD Point in Time (PIT) Count is to obtain a snapshot census of people experiencing homelessness in our area during a designated period.

The count focuses on people who, on the day of the count are:

- Sheltered (living in emergency shelters or transitional housing)
- Unsheltered (staying outdoors or places not designated for habitation, including vehicles, streets, parks and abandoned buildings)



The PIT Count is an essential element in our effort to end homelessness. The campaign presents a great opportunity to raise awareness of the myriad of challenges our homeless citizens face, hear personal stories from those experiencing homelessness, and demonstrate the compassion and generosity of the Continuum of Care community through provisions of basic items such as hats, gloves, socks and toiletries. Connections are made based on individual needs and community resources.

What to Expect

Volunteers will conduct surveys of people experiencing homelessness and connect them to services to help resolve their housing crisis.

The count will take place on January 31st between 5am and 10am. The Dixon Police Department will contact volunteers prior to this date to schedule a training. A smart phone with access to the internet is required for this count.


SENIORS OVER 80 RIDE FREE WITH READI-RIDE GOLDEN PASS
