WATER RATE ADVISORY AD HOC COMMITTEE & WATER RATE STUDY

The Water Rate Advisory Ad Hoc Committee was established by the Dixon City Council in February 2023. The Committee is made up of seven members appointed by City Council, including two City Councilmembers and five additional members from the community.

The goal of the Committee is to provide a recommendation to the City Council regarding new water rates. There is the potential for a significant water rate increase in order to maintain a reliable and safe water system.

The next Committee meeting is on April 8 at 7pm. The Committee will review draft rate increases and provide input on the rate options.
