Building

The Building Division enforces the minimum requirements of the California Building, Electrical, Mechanical, Plumbing and other local construction codes. The Division reviews plans, issues permits and inspects work on private property for conformance with the Codes. Permits are required for any sort of new construction, remodels, additions or tenant improvements.

ENGINEERING & UTILITIES
